



Welcome to Aviation 101

This course is 0.5 credit elective offered through partnership with Wausau Flying Service and Wausau Area Virtual Education (WAVE), and through grant and community funding.

Students selected to participate in this course will have classroom instruction taught by Dr. Jerry Reinardy using Angle of Attack curriculum through the WAVE infrastructure. Additionally, these students will complete loggable simulator hours at the Wausau Airport with FAA certified flight instructors using an FAA approved flight simulator.

This course is 18 weeks in length.

Student Expectations:

- Work on your Angle of Attack curriculum daily- schedule it as part of your “school day”
- Take your classroom studies seriously; you are learning to fly
- Be on pace with assignments
- Attend 14 sessions of assigned simulator hours
- Respond to communication promptly
- Ask questions when you have them
- Attend other meetings as scheduled

Parent Expectations:

- Check student progress
- Provide transportation (if needed) to the Wausau Airport for simulator hours & meetings
- Encourage and support your student’s learning

Supplies Needed:

- Computer and internet access for classroom studies
- Notebook/folder for organizing notes and handouts
